

Chemung County Summary of Vision Care Benefits

The Vision Care program has an established fixed schedule of allowances for basic vision care services including examinations, eyeglass frames, eyeglass lenses, and contact lenses. A patient may choose a service or eyeglass product more expensive than the schedule of allowance, but the patient is responsible for paying the difference between the cost allowed in the schedule of allowances and the actual price charged.

Payments under the Plan are based on the allowable amount. The allowable amount is the amount paid to a professional provider for services covered under the Plan. The patient must utilize the services of a participating provider (list on reverse side). No benefit will be issued if a non-participating provider is utilized. In the event the patient is a retiree residing out-of-area, a non-participating provider may be utilized and payment will be made according to the schedule of allowances. The employee is responsible for paying the provider directly for services or materials beyond the scheduled allowance. The charges above the scheduled allowance (except for disposable lenses) will be discounted 15% by the provider.

Dependents are covered up to the age of 19, full time students to the age of 25.

The Vision Care plan has the following frequency limitations:

Examinations: Once each calendar year

Contact Lenses or Lenses: One set of lenses each calendar year

Frames: One pair of frames every 2 calendar years

(Calendar year = January through December.)

Replacement of broken Lens/Lenses or Frames: Within one year.

Consists of replacement of lens/lenses or frames of the same prescription and the same material as that which was originally prescribed.
