Permit applicants must provide the following:

1-NY State Big Game License with bow or muzzledloading hunting privileges, depending on the implement used - bow privilege for archery equipment, and muzzleloading privilege for crossbows.

2-A non-ambulatory hunting permit issued by the DEC, or a signed certification from their licensed physician certifying the need for the applicant to be in a mechanized aid, and the nature, degree and term of the applicant's physical disability.

3-Sign a "hold-harmless" agreement in form and content satisfactory to the County Attorney prior to receipt of the special bow hunting permit for the PARK form the COUNTY. These documents must be in the possession of the permit holder at all times while at Park Station.

Each non-ambulatory County-permit hunter must hunt with a bow, or crossbow if legally authorized and qualified to hunt with such by the State of New York.

A qualified applicant for this permit must be an archery hunter with a physical disability who is unable to move about except with the use of a mechanized aid. A mechanized aid is defined as a wheelchair or other similarly mechanically powered device.

You must submit the above verification with your application.
