RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE CHEMUNG COUNTY GEOGRAPHIC  
INFORMATION SYSTEMS COOPERATIVE

WHEREAS, for some years now the various units of the county and local governments throughout the County of Chemung have shared on an informal basis their expertise with respect to the development and utilization of the geographic information systems (“GIS”) technology and to apply the GIS technology to both the public and private sectors; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has proposed the establishment of the Chemung County GIS Cooperative, which would be charged with the broad mandate to keep the community apprised of changing technologies and make recommendations for the use of GIS technology that would promote economic development and to facilitate coordination by developing policies that will ensure that all new geo-based data is developed in a GIS compatible format using appropriate mapping standards and to approve procedures relating to the timely update of community mapping, and to improve access to and use and understanding of GIS technology; and

WHEREAS, the Multi-Services Committee of this Legislature has reviewed the proposal and recommended the formation of the Chemung County GIS Cooperative to implement the aforementioned mandates; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this Legislature does hereby authorize and establish a Chemung County GIS Cooperative to establish policies and procedures to implement the above-stated mandates as well as such other mandates as shall be directed by the County Executive or this Legislature; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Chemung County GIS Cooperative shall be composed of the members as shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that those individuals to fill vacancies on the Cooperative shall be appointed by the Chemung County Executive, subject to the approval of this Legislature.
